The Foundation: Routine Care

Simple, consistent care is the key to keeping your Beech wood looking pristine.

- Dusting: Dust regularly with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to prevent abrasive particles from scratching the surface.
- Cleaning: For general cleaning, use a cloth slightly dampened with water. Always wipe
 in the direction of the grain and immediately follow with a dry cloth. Beech is porous,
 so minimizing moisture is crucial.

A Note on Steam Beech

The steaming process doesn't just change the color of the wood to a warmer, pinkish tone; it also makes the timber more stable and less prone to movement. This means it's more resilient to changes in indoor humidity. The care for the *finish*, however, remains the same. The primary goal is to protect the durable top coat.

Critical Mistakes to Avoid with Beech Wood

- Never Use Excessive Water: Spills should be wiped up immediately. Standing water can soak into the grain and cause staining or swelling.
- Avoid Harsh Chemicals: Never use cleaners with ammonia, vinegar, or abrasive powders. These can damage the protective finish and dull the wood's natural beauty.
