#### **The Foundation: Routine Care**

Simple, consistent care is the key to keeping your White Ash looking pristine.

- **Dusting:** Dust regularly with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth (like microfiber). This is especially important for a light-colored wood, as dust can become more visible.
- **Cleaning:** For general cleaning, use a cloth slightly dampened with water. Always wipe in the direction of the grain and immediately follow with a dry cloth to ensure no moisture is left behind.

#### **Protecting the Finish**

Like White Oak, your White Ash is protected by a durable top-coat finish. The primary goal is to keep this protective layer in perfect condition.

- **Gentle Cleaning:** For fingerprints or minor smudges, a wood-safe cleaner or a solution of mild soap and water on a dampened cloth is ideal. Apply to the cloth, not the wood. Clean the spot gently, rinse with a water-dampened cloth, and dry thoroughly.
- **Avoid Yellowing:** The bright, creamy color of Ash is its main appeal. To prevent it from yellowing over time, avoid prolonged exposure to direct, harsh sunlight and exposure to oils or waxes that have a strong amber tint.

#### **Critical Mistakes to Avoid with White Ash**

- **Never Use Excessive Water:** Spills should be wiped up immediately to prevent water from penetrating the finish and grain.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Never use cleaners with ammonia, vinegar, or abrasive powders. These can strip the protective finish and dull the wood's natural beauty.

- **Prevent Scratches and Dents:** While tough, Ash can still be scratched. Use felt pads under all objects placed on the surface. Lift, don't drag, furniture and heavy items.
